

The L.I.F.T. Study

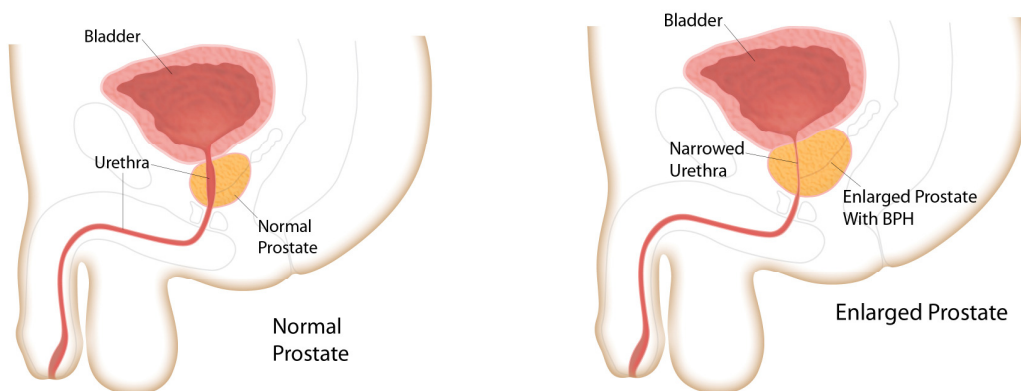

The purpose of the study is to establish the safety and effectiveness of the UroLift® System* for the treatment of lower urinary tract symptoms (LUTS) due to benign prostatic hyperplasia (BPH). The L.I.F.T. Study is a clinical investigation being conducted in Australia, the United States and Canada for the purposes of market approval in the U.S. by the Food and Drug Administration (FDA).

Do I Qualify?

- Are you a man age 50 or older?
- Do you have to urinate frequently during the day and at night?
- Do you have trouble urinating?
- Are these and other urinary problems interfering with your life and your relationships?

About BPH

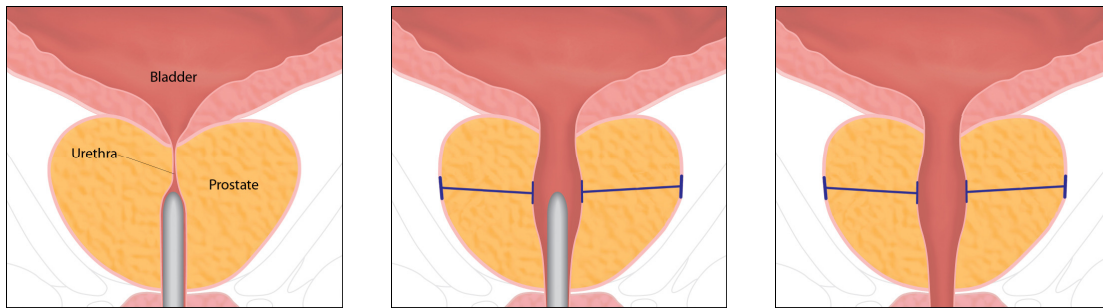


The prostate is a gland that surrounds the urethra, the tube that drains urine from the body. Benign prostatic hyperplasia (BPH) is a non-cancerous condition that causes the prostate to enlarge as men age. When the enlarged prostate presses on the urethra, it can cause bothersome urinary symptoms.

UroLift® System* Treatment

The UroLift System* is a minimally invasive approach to treating BPH that lifts or holds the enlarged prostate tissue out of the way so it no longer blocks the urethra. There is no cutting, heating or removal of prostate tissue. The goal of UroLift system* treatment is to relieve symptoms so you can get back to your life and resume your daily activities.

How It Works:



- Step 1:** The UroLift delivery device* is placed through the urethra to access the enlarged prostate.
- Step 2:** Small UroLift sutures* are permanently placed to lift or hold the enlarged prostate tissue out of the way and increase the opening of the urethra.
- Step 3:** The UroLift delivery device* is removed, leaving a more open urethra to provide symptom relief.
